



ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE GENERAL LEGAL COUNCIL

DISBARMENT OF LAWYER SAMUEL NERQUAYE-TETTEH FROM LEGAL PRACTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 23rd November 2023 an order was made by the Disciplinary Committee of the General Legal Council acting in pursuance of the provisions of section 20 of the Legal Profession Act, 1960 (Act 32) as amended and Regulation 20 of the Legal Profession (Disciplinary Committee) Rules, 2020 (L.I. 2424) that **SAMUEL NERQUAYE-TETTEH** should be struck off the Roll of Lawyers in Ghana.

The above-named lawyer was charged and convicted on one count under Rule 2(2) of the Legal Profession (Professional Conduct and Etiquette) Rules, 1969 (L.I. 613) as follows:

Count 1

That he, as a lawyer and a Chief State Attorney, having acted as counsel for the State in the case intituled **Alfred Agbesi Woyome vrs. Attorney General & Anor** had an amount of Four Hundred Thousand Ghana Cedis (GHC 400,000.00) transferred directly from Mr. Alfred Woyome into the bank account of his wife, Mrs. Gifty Nerquaye-Tetteh on 16th June 2011 without any reasonable explanation; a conduct or act that adversely affects the dignity and high standing of the legal profession.

SAMUEL NERQUAYE-TETTEH shall not hold himself out as a lawyer or attend chambers or render or purport to render any professional legal services to the public. The practicing licence of Samuel Nerquaye-Tetteh is hereby withdrawn forthwith.
