FORMER PRESIDENT AKUFO-ADDO HOSTS NPP PRESIDENTIAL ASPIRANTS FOR BREAKFAST MEETING

Former President Nana Addo Dankwa Akufo-Addo, on Tuesday, 21st October 2025, hosted a breakfast meeting with the five presidential aspirants of the New Patriotic Party (NPP) at his private residence in Nima, Accra.
