JOINT MILITARY/POLICE SWOOPS IN ASHANTI, VOLTA AND AHAFO REGIONS

The Ghana Armed Forces and Ghana Police Service are conducting simultaneous targeted and intelligence led joint swoops in the Ashanti Region specifically, Dadwene and Anwona, in the Volta Region at Ehi and in the Ahafo Region at Hwedem, Kenyase, Guaso and Marhani.

The operations which started at dawn today, Wednesday 12 November 2025 at all the locations aim at arresting identified persons involved in the recent attacks on members of the National Anti-Illegal Mining Operations Secretariat (NAIMOS) team, some Police officers and officials of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) including journalists. The Armed Forces and the Police Service warn that any individual or group that attempts to obstruct the operations of any of the security services in their anti-galamsey operations or in the performance of any other lawful duty, will face the full force of the law.

The Armed Forces and the Police Service wish to assure the general public that adequate measures have been put in place to ensure the safety and security of well-meaning inhabitants of these towns and communities. They are encouraged to remain calm and go about their regular duties without fear or panic.

The Security Services commend civil society groups, the media and individuals for the massive condemnation on the unwarranted attacks and disruption of activities of the security forces in their anti-galamsey drive and counts on the continuous cooperation of the general public.
